Principals Report		
	Dale spoke about staffing and budgets for next year, he is currently working through it all.	
	Feedback provided from the school survey that was certainly completed. The staff had a few questions for the parent body around the results.	
	Learning websites for each year would be great for parents to be more involved and understand homework that is being sent home. Learning websites or informational sites for parents to	

help students learn more at home to the level of what they are learning in the classroom. Homework to be sent home for all years, whether it is marked or not. Students do not have to complete it but an effect to be made is great. Workshops, information nights or weblinks in the newsletter around bullying for both parents and students. The parent forum believes the feedback from the survey is based around parents' understanding of what bullying is. How it affects students and how parents are able to help the school with bullying, if it is occurring. Dale spoke about Elle (Miss Stokes) will be finishing up in 2 weeks. A number of parents asked about the uniform policy and brought up concerns around students not wearing the correct uniform. A notification/reminder will be sent out on compass and if a student has worn the incorrect uniform a note will be sent home as a reminder of what is required to be worn. It was noted that during the cooler months some students do wear the incorrect jumper. Another reminder about the clothing pool to be sent out on compass, reminding parents that donations are welcome as well. Fathers Day BBQ and Stall - the stall will be held on Monday the 1st due to Stage 3 being away. The Fathers Day BBQ will be held on Monday 8th due to stage 3 being away and unable to hold it on the Friday before Fathers Day. Year 6 Graduation Has the venue been booked or is there a chance to change it? There has been some feedback from parents that last year it was really noisy and very hard to hard due to the bingo numbers being called at the Bowling Club. An email is to be put together and sent to Louise, Lauren and Dale to see if an alternate venue can be arranged. Dale has advised they did ask to be put closer to the stage, instead of right in the back of the room. In previous years it was held at the pub however the food took a long time to be received and the sun from the deck was uncomfortable for all guests.
